*Please note that the JI does not provide transportation and that all students will need to provide a permission slip signed by their parent or guardian.

Brain Boot Camps will begin at 9:30 AM and last approximately 2.5 hours. They will start with an introduction to the Jacobs Institute, a walking tour of our facility including 3D printed models, and explanation of why our location between a private hospital and university research center is unique. The students will also learn briefly about heart attack and stroke prevalence in Western New York, and some strategies for reducing risk in their own lives.

All Brain Boot Camp attendees will have the chance to participate in a biomedical engineering activity and try their hand on a medical simulator. Each of these activities are approximately 40 minutes.

For the remainder of the Brain Boot Camp, the JI can customize your visit to address what you and your students would be most interested in doing. Please select one (1) of the three additional learning modules for your students. Each module is approximately 20 minutes.

- Hear from a professional in STEM or Healthcare (Is there a specific specialty you hope to hear from? No guarantees.)
- Understand heart attack & stroke treatments
- Watch a pre-recorded surgery
